Tournament Rules

- The tournament will be USBC Certified and all USBC rules shall apply.
- The 15-pin rule (319e) is waived.
- All participants must be 2025–2026 USBC members. Non-members may compete by paying a \$5.00 USBC participation fee.
- Each participant may enter each event twice. Bowlers may cash once in singles, once in doubles with the same partner, and once in teams.
- All Events will be based on the first time you bowl. All prize fees shall be returned 100%.
- The prize ratio for singles, doubles and teams will be at least 1:8. For All Events it will be at least 1:15.
- Bowlers will use their highest USBC certified average with 21 games or more at the end of the 2024–2025 bowling season.
- If no previous certified average has ever been obtained, bowler may use their highest certified average with 6 games or more.
- Failure to use current average shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than the correct average. Prize winnings shall be based on correct average.
- If current season average for at least 21 games at the time of bowling exceeds last season's average by 10 or more pins, current average shall be used.
- Bowlers who have qualified for a prize of \$300.00 or more in a tournament in the past 12 months must report to the Tournament Director.
- Estimated prizes for first place in doubles, singles, team and all events are based on 22 team entries.
- The tournament is limited to the first 22 teams. Entries close November 8, 2025 at 9:00 a.m.
- The Tournament Director shall settle all disputes not covered by USBC rules.
